A refreshing, medium bodied, Sauvignon Blanc with citrus aromas that can match a wide range of foods.

Villa Antinori Bianco 2014, Tuscany, Italy £28.00

Intense aromatic & floral notes of ripe fruit, fresh medium-bodied palate with a lingering finish.

Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, 2014 £55.50

A well-known name in quality Sauvignon Blanc with lots of appealing fruit & a crisp acidity to finish.

Vincent Girardin, Puligny-Montrachet Les Enseignerres, 2012 £95.00

A young white Burgundy with aromas of fresh apples and pear, citrus notes and a light hazelnut palate.

Villa Antinori Rosso 2013, Tuscany, Italy £30.00

Ripe fruits, plum, mint, chocolate, & tobacco. A complex, stylish wine with a soft palate.

Stags Leap, Hawk Crest Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 £40.00

This is textbook California Cabernet, with dark fruit, red cherry and black pepper spice notes.

On the palate, the wine is medium-bodied with inviting blueberry pie and cocoa flavours.

FRANCE

LOIRE

24. **Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine, Chereau Carré, 2013** £29.00

A clean, crisp acidity with bright fresh minerals. Dry as expected from the Melon de Bourgogne.

25. **Sancerre Le Mont, Foucher Lebrun 2013** £43.00

Crisp, flavoursome Sancerre which offers floral and boxwood aromas.

The palate shows juicy citrus fruit alongside the trademark elegance and minerality of the appellation.

26. **Pouilly Fume, Jean - Max Roger, 2013** £59.00

This Pouilly Fume has intensity and aromatic richness. Flint soil adds a smoky touch of gunflint while clay soil lends floral notes and brings out the wine's richness on the palate.

BURGUNDY

30. **Chablis, Domaine Sainte Claire, Jean-Marc Brocard, 2012** £44.00

The nose is precise, pure and mineral, with additional notes of citrus.

The palate is classic Chablis: structured, crisp and delicious, with flavours echoing the nose.

31. **Mâcon La Roche, Vineuse, 2012** £46.00

Pale gold in colour this wonderful wine has notes of orange blossom, lemon, pear and peach with a touch of mineral undertone. Well balanced with fantastic acidity.

32. **Saint Veran, Domaine des Deux Roches, Les Chailloux, 2012** £53.00

Showing plenty of rich fruit and cream on the nose which also follows through on the palate.

A delightful freshness and minerality with a touch of soft spice and a creamy orange long finish.

33. **Vincent Gardin Saint Aubin 1er Cru En Remilly, 2012** £86.00

A wine of finesse and elegance, but not short on power: citrus notes overlay rich apple fruit, and the finish is long, precise and mineral.

BORDEAUX

34. **Château Beau Mayne, Sauvignon Blanc, Vignobles Dourthe/Thienot, 2012** £33.00

Dry, bright and zesty Sauvignon Blanc with clean, crisp lemon and grapefruit notes and refreshing green fruit flavour.

OTHER FRENCH REGION

38. **Viognier/Grenache Blanc, Domaine Coste, France** £26.00
Gently aromatic, with honeysuckle and apricot on the nose and delicate flavours of nuts and citrus.
39. **La Doutelle Sauvignon Blanc, Rhone, France, 2012** £22.00
Aromas of green apples with rich, dry greengage & grapefruit characteristics with a long elegant finish. Rich and crisp on the palate.
40. **Delas Viognier, Languedoc-Roussillon, 2013** £29.00
Bursting with Viognier character: apricots, peaches and preserved citrus fruit.
The palate is both smooth and fresh, with hints of spice.
41. **Chardonnay, Les Templiers, Vin de Pays, 2014** £23.00
Crisp, ripe wine with refreshingly clean citrus fruit flavours and a rounded finish.
42. **Picpoul de Pinet, Hugues de beauvignac, Coteaux du Languedoc, 2014** £26.00
Elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers and a crisp, mineral palate ideally suited to seafood.

ENGLAND

45. **New Hall Vineyards, Essex, Signature, 2013** £32.50
A dry wine, crisp and clean with rich flavours and long smooth finish. This is an ideal wine to enjoy with a meal or by its self.

GERMANY

47. **White Rabbit Riesling, Rhein, 2013** £28.50
A versatile Riesling with or without food, a hint of grass & herbs on the palate with white blossoms & tropical fruit on the nose.

SPAIN

49. **Rioja Blanco Barrica, Conde de Valdemar, Bodegas Valdemar, 2012** £36.00
A successful blend of modern fruit and traditional oak ageing. Lemony smokey and vanilla scented, with subtle aromas of peaches and apricot, and beautifully balanced.

ITALY

50. **Pinot Grigio, Terre del Noce, IGT 2014** £24.00
Elegant, dry Pinot Grigio with apple and banana fruit aromas, floral lift in the mouth, and a clean, crisp finish
51. **Codici Fiano, Puglia IGT, 2013** £26.00
This characterful grape from southern Italy gives a rich, peachy style balanced by a lively citrus crispness.

52. Santa Christina, Campogrande, Orvieto, 2013 £29.00
Straw yellow in colour, delicate aromas of fruit and flowers with notes of tropical fruit & orange blossoms. fresh and supple on the palate, savoury on the finish with white fruit aftertaste.

53. Gavi di Gavi La Meirana, Bruno Broglio, Piedmont, 2013 £39.00
Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi.

CHILE

60. Sauvignon Blanc, Santa Rita Gran Hacienda, 2014 £23.00
Crisp and refreshing, with aromas of grapefruit and lemon peel, lending a fresh balance to the tropical fruit character. Vibrant and well-rounded.

61. Lapostolle, Casa, Semillon, Rapel Valley, 2012 £27.50
Expressive nose with mineral flinty notes combined with mandarin & vanilla, cinnamon & clove coming from the oak. Easy-drinking, medium-bodied, with a tangy crispness towards the finish.

62. Lapostolle Cuvée Alexandre Organic Chardonnay, Casablanca Valley, 2012 £46.00
Intense fruit aromas of sweet citrus fruit, white flowers, fresh tropical fruits and sweet spices. Elegant and concentrated in the mouth, with a creamy texture balanced by a crisp citrusy edge.

ARGENTINA

66. Finca La Colonnia Colección Chardonnay, Mendoza, 2014 £27.50
Delicate aromas of pear and red apple lead to a refined, refreshing palate in which ripe fruit is balanced by subtle savoury and vanilla notes. Clean, dry and satisfying on the finish

67. Terrazas de los Andes, Torrontés, 2012 £45.50
Unoaked, a fruity & fresh wine with a good acidity on the palate, aromas of orange blossom & rose with fruit notes of pear, mango & passion fruit.

USA

68. Chardonnay, Camino Cellars, Monterey County, California, 2011 £38.00
Unoaked and full of lemon fruit with a buttery, creamy finish, a very moreish Chardonnay.

69. Firestone Riesling, Central Coast, California 2013 £38.00
Exudes flavors and aromas of green apple, lemon and lime zest, mandarin, jasmine tea and just the right amount of sweetness.

NEW ZEALAND

- 70. Featherdrop Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, 2014** £27.00
Lively aromas of gooseberry, passion fruits, grapefruit and crisp red capsicum. Bold flavour of lemon, lime, grapefruit and gooseberry tantalize the palate and provide refreshing clean finish.
- 72. Select Vineyards "Bell Ringer" Albariño, Gisborne, 2013** £43.00
New Zealand's first Albariño, this wine is an exuberant, zesty affair brimming with white peach & melon reined in by a citrus & mineral character.
- 74. Cloudy Bay 'TE KOKE' Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, 2011** £91.00
This Sauvignon Blanc from Cloudy Bay is a more mature wine than others which is complex & savoury on the palate with richness & aromatics. It is a full bodied wine with a hint of smokey oak.

AUSTRALIA

- 75. Deakin Estate Chardonnay, Victoria, 2014** £29.00
This Chardonnay shows aromas of ripe pear, nectarine and apple.
The palate is ripe and smooth with delicious fruit character without being over the top.

SOUTH AFRICA

- 80. Kanu Chenin Blanc, 2013** £25.00
A nose of melon, flowers and savoury notes with some honey-spiced fruit leads to a tropical palate that combines depth of fruit with a bright, crisp finish.
- 81. Mulderbosh, Stellenbosh, Sauvignon Blanc, 2013** £44.00
Clear, lively green apple hues. A tropical nose packed with guava, ripe and green fig, granadilla, litchi, gooseberry and a hint of green pepper-yet still maintaining a complex character of nettle and freshly cut grass. The mouth-filling ripe fruit is supported by crisp acid.

100. **Château des Vierres, Beaujolais-Villages, 2013** £32.00
Attractive cherry colour with a bouquet of strawberry & blackcurrant. Smooth & well balanced.
101. **Château des Capitans, Juliéna, 2012** £46.00
Delicious, complex wine full of blueberry & jasmine.
This wine is rich & expressive while retaining its juiciness.

BORDEAUX

103. **Château Vieux Fouquet 2011** £27.00
Deep purple colour, fresh red fruit aromas with cherry & plum,
very well balanced with smooth tannins & a fruity finish.
104. **Château Garreau, Bordeaux Supérieur, 2011** £32.00
Brooding dark fruit and earth on the nose, with firm tannins and acidity on the palate
Supporting flavours of cloves, cinnamon, blackcurrant and cassis.
105. **Château de Pavillon, Canon Fronsac, 2010** £48.00
Very popular and dependable Bordeaux from this quality region close to
St Emilion. Ripe blackcurrant fruit with a chocolaty smoothness on the palate.
Lovely cigar box aromas.
106. **Château Rahoul, Portets, 2009** £71.00
Beaumont is crisp, classical claret with understated cassis fruit,
a hint of black pepper and a long fresh finish.
107. **Château de Pez, Saint- Estèphe, 2009** £99.00
Deep and dark in colour. Very complex nose of mature fruits
with a touch of wood. Beautiful tannic structure and long aftertaste.

BURGUNDY

110. Le Bourgogne, Pinot Noir, Chanson Père Et Fils, 2012 £42.50

A super example of the regions famous grape. Intense aromas of violet and liquorice with a hint of spice. Concentrated and well-structured which is refreshing and lively in the mouth.

RHONE

120. Côtes du Rhone, M. Chapoutier, 2013 £29.50

The colour of garnet red with aromas of Morello cherries and spices,

This wine has great structure with firm and silky tannins.

121. Crozes Hermitage, Les Launes, Delas Freres, 2012 £44.00

A fresh, medium-bodied Crozes, with aromas of cassis, plums and violets, alongside the tale black pepper. The palate offers a supple mouthfeel and a fine mineral finish

123. Châteauneuf du Pape, Domaine La Boutinere, 2012 £72.00

An elegant wine which can be drunk young. It has ripe fruits of the forest; is smooth and well balanced.

OTHER FRENCH REGION

124. La Doutelle Merlot, Igp D'oc, Languedoc Roussillon, France £24.00

Round and well balanced with plum and berry flavours and a smooth finish, all supported by ripe tannins.

125. Les Templiers Pinot Noir 2013 £27.00

Vibrant nose of strawberries, raspberries & spice leading to an elegant palate, medium bodied with juicy red fruit.

126. Côtes Du Roussillon, Cuvée Authentique, Domaine Lafage, 2012 £36.00

Rich purple red colour. Intense fruity nose with overwhelming flower, chocolate, liquorish and garrigue aromas. Rich, pleasant structured and an elegant palate.

127. Corbieres, Chateau Serres, Sainte Lucie, France £26.00

A vibrant, spicy Corbières that combines juicy ripe berry fruit with a coffee and mineral finish.

ITALY

- 130. Nero d'Avola, Sangiovese Sicilia IGT, Sicily, 2013** £25.00
This Sicilian red, expresses juicy red fruits, with a beautiful rounded body that progresses onto a long and fresh finish.
- 131. Itynera Primitivo, Salento IGT, Puglia, 2013** £26.00
Deep ruby red colour with violet reflections, intense aroma, fruity with notes of plum and cherry, spicy, with rosemary and vanilla scent. A full bodied wine, soft and balanced.
- 132. Santa Christina, Le Maestrelle, Toscana, 2013** £34.00
Ruby red in colour with purple highlights, intense aromas of red fruit together with chocolate and mint, the wine is balanced of good fullness with velvety tannins.
- 133. Anitonori, Pèppoli, Chianti Classico, 2012** £46.00
Ruby red in color, this wine has notes of cherries well intergrated with the chocolate and vanilla aromas of the oak aging . The palate shows much sangiovese verietal character. The tannins are soft and silky with the flavours long and well sustained.
- 134. Prunotto, Barolo, Piedmont, 2010** £72.00
Complex nose with notes of violet and forest fruits. Floral, smoky and intensely elegant on the palate, this is Barolo at its best.

SPAIN

- 140. Candidato Barrica 3 Tempranillo, La Mancha, 2012** £23.00
Impressively concentrated Rioja-style wine, with vanilla oak seasoning the lush rhubarb and strawberry fruit.
- 141. Bodegas Ignacio Old Vine Garnacha, Aragón, 2008** £34.00
Sumptuous Garnacha, with the richness and density you can only get from old, low-yielding vines.
Dark fruit is balanced by spice and herbal notes.
- 142. Rioja, Conde De Valdemar Reserva, Bodegas Valdemar, 2008** £43.00
Complex aromas with subtle spicy notes and ripe black fruit touches.
Potent and fleshy, taste of ripe fruits and oak. Long and persistent finish.
- 143. Bogera, Numanthia, Castillo y Leon, Toro, 2009** £96.00
Deep dark bright red with light ruby tones. Both intense and complex, aromas of red & black fruits, perfectly integrated with sweet spices of vanilla and toasted characters. Long and elegant on the finish

NEW ZEALAND

- 146. Pinot Noir, Borthwick vineyard, Wairarapa 2010** £52.00
Traditional Burgundian, techniques and minimal handling has produced a Pinot Noir with an intense bouquet of cherries and plums. Flavours of tobacco and spice complement a rich silky palate with a purity of fruit and finely integrated tannin structure.
- 147. Cloudy Bay Pinot Noir, Marlborough, 2011** £81.00
A complex medium bodied wine with savoury flavours & a ripe supple palate

CHILE

- 150. Merlot, Santa Rita Gran Hacienda, Rapel Valley, 2013** £23.00
This Merlot has a complex aroma combining ripe black fruits and sweet plums with vanilla and spice notes. Concentrated palate with a very ripe smooth structure.
- 151. Carmenere Reserva, Haras de Pirque, Maipo Valley, 2013** £27.00
Mint, graphite and lots of fresh fruit on the nose, especially black fruit and blueberries. The palate is spicy with rosemary and cinnamon notes, and a smooth, supple mouth feel with good balance and concentration.
- 152. Lapostolle Canto, de Apalta, Rapel Valley, 2012** £33.00
Deliciously juicy yet immensely refined blend. Luxurious fruit aromas are framed by tobacco & chocolate, while the palate combines serious depth with a smooth, rounded texture
- 153. Hussonet Gran Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon, Maipo Valley, 2011** £38.00
Nose with notes of mint, spices and liquorice, leading into ripe flavours of black fruits: blackberry, plum and cassis. Generously structured on the palate with a seam of earthy minerality.
- 154. Lapostolle Cuvée Alexandre Pinot Noir, Casablanca Valley, 2012** £54.00
Intense aromas of red berries and spices, with vanilla and rose complexity.
Medium-full bodied with a firm Pinot structure, this is long and aromatic in the mouth.

ARGENTINA

155. **Malbec la Nina, Mendoza, 2014** £28.00
A typical intense purple Malbec with full aromas of cherries and plums. Attractive fruity flavour, balanced, complex and charming.
156. **Masi Passo Doble, Mendoza, 2012** £36.00
70% Malbec, 30% Semi-dried Corvina, Fragrant and complex on the nose with ripe fruit aromas enhanced by notes of prune and liquorice. Up-front and powerful on the palate with hints of spice and cooked cherries followed by a long appetizing finish.
157. **Terrazas de los Andes, Malbec, Mendoza, 2012** £46.00
Aromas of black cherries, prunes & raisins with vanilla & violets. The palate has good body & structure with lots of power yet a round & soft character.
158. **Cheval Des Andes, Mendoza, 2010** £126.00
Deep black cherry colour, aromas of dried apricots, floral notes mix with warm scents of tobacco, red berry fruit with cedar-wood, bay leaves & chocolate. The palate is warm and balanced, with freshness & minerals along with black currant, spices & almond. Highly integrated, sweet tannins mingle with a long and elegant finish.

AUSTRALIA

160. **Cabernet Sauvignon, Deakin Estate, Victoria 2013** £26.00
A characteristically elegant Cabernet, full of cassis, cinnamon and hints of spicy oak. The palate is medium-bodied and juicy, with a nice savoury finish.
161. **Three Gardens Shiraz/Mourvedre/Grenache, Langmeil, Barossa, 2012** £36.00
Rich, ripe and plush in texture, the flavours centring on cherry and exotic spices, picking up a hint of peppermint. Supple and generous, a lithe mouthful of black pepper scented blackberry, liquorice and toasty oak flavours that mingle effortlessly through the long, well-mannered finish.
162. **Chapel Hill, Parsons Nose Shiraz, McLaren Vale, 2013** £42.00
Classic Shiraz aromas of blueberries, blackberries and cinnamon lead to a luscious yet lively palate that balances typical McLaren Vale fruit density with a floral-spicy lift.

SOUTH AFRICA

165. **Pinotage, Porter Mill Station, 2013** £26.50
Bright purple colour with none of the burnt rubber characteristics often associated with this variety. Light bodied with fruity raspberry flavours and a gripping tannic finish.
166. **Baldrick, Shiraz Vandeling, Voor-Paardeberg, 2012** £34.00
Rich deep purple colour. Shiraz provides the heart and soul in the form of palate, volume, dark fruits, subtle pepper and other exotic spices.
167. **Buitenverwachting Christine, Constantia, 2009** £51.00
An exquisite Bordeaux-style blend with rich red fruit characters reminiscent of ripe cherry and blackcurrant, and undertones of dark chocolate and tobacco.

USA

170. **Zinfandel Sebastiani, California, 2012** £33.00
Very smooth and juicy, with ripe black fruit and no hard edges – a gentle giant.
172. **Lost Angel California Cabernet Sauvignon, 2014** £31.50
Focused aromas of tea and cherry with concentrated fruit flavours and smooth tannins.

LEBANON

175. **Chateau Musar, Hochar, Bekaa Valley, 2005** £71.00
Stunning lighter red than with Musar itself. Style is almost claret meets Rhone soft fruits with attractive spice and berry finish, very easy drinking red wine and food perfect.

ROSÉ WINES

CHILE

200. Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé, Santa Rita Gran Hacienda, 2014 £24.00

A full-on fruity rosé with a vibrant colour, masses of berry flavour and a dry yet well-rounded palate.

FRANCE

201. Côtes de Provence Rosé, Carte Noire, 2014 £31.00

Very refined dry rosé, with an attractive floral aroma, redcurrant fruit, and excellent length in the mouth.

ITALY

202. Pinot Grigio Rosé Rosato Mannara, Sicily, 2013 £23.00

A delicate rosé with lifted aromas of spring flowers and strawberries, red berry fruit on the palate and a soft, round finish.

HALF BOTTLES

CHAMPAGNE

300. Canard-Duchene, Cuvee Leonie Brut, NV £31.00

Hints of nuts and pastry on the nose and this is balanced by a palate which displays a lively apple fruitiness and clean lemon citrus edge.

WHITE WINES

301. Sauvignon Blanc, Santa Rita Gran Hacienda, Rapel Valley, 2013 £16.00

Crisp and refreshing, with aromas of grapefruit and lemon peel, lending a fresh balance to the tropical fruit character. Vibrant and well-rounded.

302. Chablis, Domaine Sainte Claire, 2012 £24.00

Brilliant colour with green highlights. The mouth has a classic structure, crunchy and delicious with notes of citrus fruits and minerality.

303. Sancerre Les Boffants, Charles Dupuy, 2013 £28.00

This wine has herbaceous, grassy flavours, intensely fruity, clean and fresh, with flinty mineral notes.

RED WINES

A very popular and dependable Bordeaux from this quality region close to St Emilion.

Ripe blackcurrant fruit with a chocolaty smoothness on the palate. Lovely cigar box aromas.
